Water Resistance: Bottom of machine is not water resistant

Washable: Arm and pin washable in dishwasher. The product itself is washable

except the bottom (do not wash it upside down)

Material/Exterior: ABS resin

Material/Other: SUS303/304/30, WPB/430/440J2(Blades), POM

Maintenance: Wash it at least once per day when in use. Check that all parts

are functioning properly. Spray silicon to moving parts.

Warranty: One (1) year or under 1000 hours of use
